Weather Policy

Huron Playschool Co-operative, through staff and active involvement of parents, provides a safe and nurturing outdoor environment where children are encouraged to develop their creative and constructive capacities through play.

Outdoor activities are dependent on environmental conditions. In the event that the temperature is -15°C or lower with the wind chill, we will remain indoors. During warmer months the UV index, smog or heat alerts will be taken into consideration. If the UV is above 9.0 or there is a smog or heat alert there will be no outdoor time after 11:00 a.m.

Environment Canada's weather information service could be the deciding factor, and a teacher or co-op parent may call 416-661-0123. The Teacher/Director will make the decision.

Each day your child should have appropriate clothing for outdoor time. The outdoor conditions can change dramatically. Your child will want to be comfortable outdoors. Warm weather requires sunhats and sunscreen (please apply before coming to Playschool). Winter weather requires snow pants, coats, boots, hats and mittens.
